GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS AND PAPER THESES FOR PUBLICATION IN CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

1. The abstract should not exceed 250–300 words and conference materials (thesis) should not exceed three pages and saved as a MS Word file.
2. All fields must be 20 mm with left indent being 1.25 mm.
3. Font: Times New Roman –14, line spacing 1.0.
4. The following information should be provided in Ukrainian and English:
 - right-aligned, upper corner– *author's first and last name (in bold), degree, academic rank and affiliation (full name)*;
 - one line should be left empty, next, center-aligned, uppercase, in bold –*paper title*;
 - one line should be left empty, next – *key words up to eight (in bold), abstract and/or conference thesis*.
5. References should be cited in the body of the text in the format of source number and pages within the source in square brackets only, example: [1, p.1215].
6. The amount of tables and figures cannot exceed 1 of each.
7. References should be presented at the end of the main text, leaving one-line empty after the main text.
